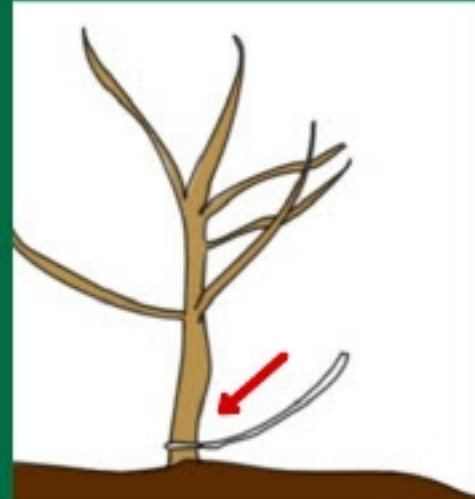
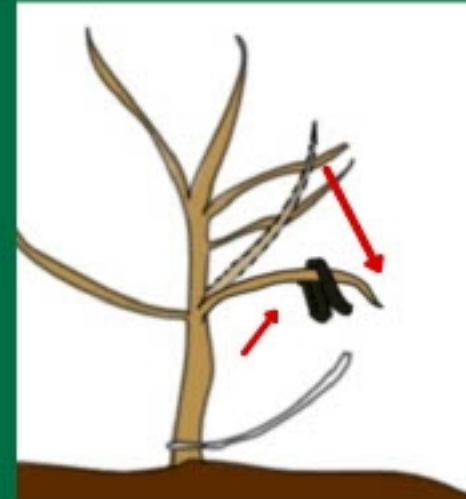


The Basics: How to use a Selfe Hook™



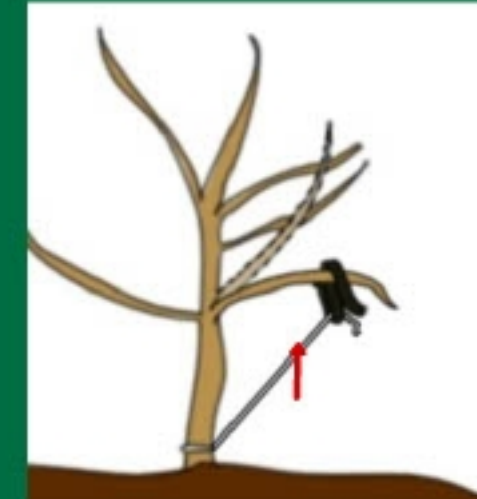
Step 1:

Secure the string at the base of the plant.



Step 2:

Hold the Selfe Hook™ in your right hand, flat side toward you, and pull the branch down with it.



Step 3:

Pass the string (can be jute, tamatietou, or materiaalstrokie) with your left hand, through the vee of the hook towards you.

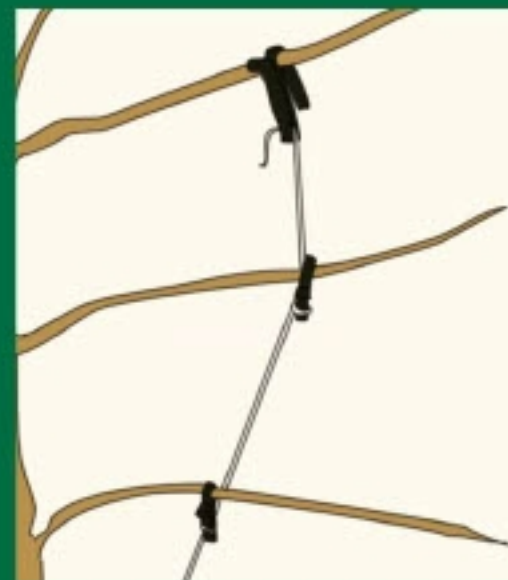
[Double loop the string for extra secure ties.]

Hook Tips



On the wire

Secure creepers and vines to trellising, chicken wire, or chain link fences, using just a Selfe Hook™.



In series

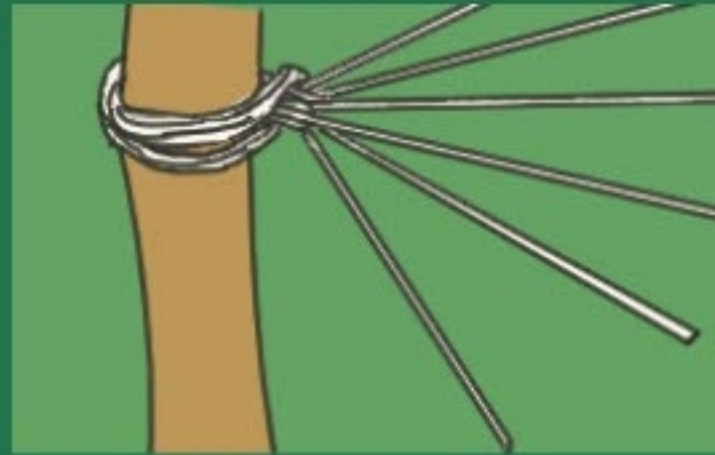
Save on string, by attaching multiple branches to the same string.



Double up

Tie trees to trellising, using two Selfe Hooks™ and a short length of string.

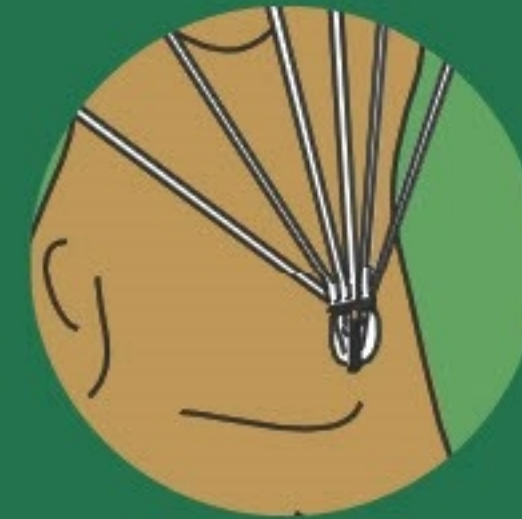
Rope Tricks



10 is better than 1

Take several jute strings, as though holding a single rope. Tie a cow hitch knot at the base of the plant, and feed the ends into multiple hooks from the same point.

OR



Staple multiple strings to the base of the tree, using a T shape, for the same result.

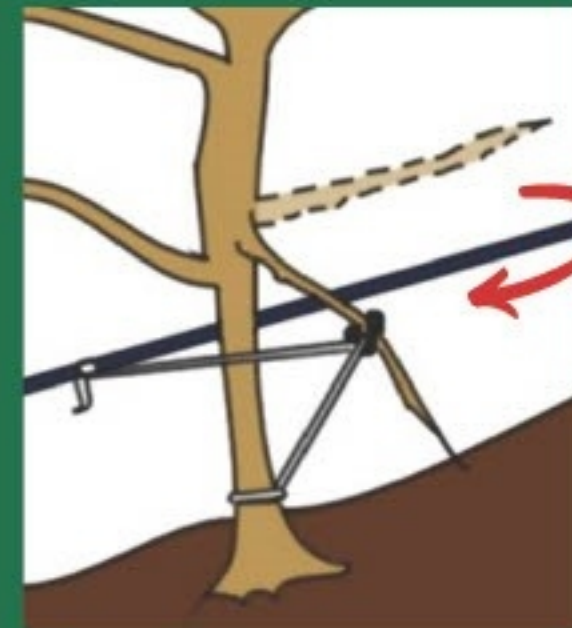
OR

Use nails instead of staples..



Wide load

For larger branches, double loop the string. Feed it under the branch, around the far end of the hook. Secure it with a final loop.



Open up

To open your trees up fully, secure the string at the base, feed it through the hook on your branch, and finally secure onto lateral trellising. This will pull the branch out into the row.
